RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, FIRE DISTRICT # 6,
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GLOUCESTER, CAMDEN COUNT, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING
FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE FIRE COMMAND VEHICLE
AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$86,000.00, PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:14-84


WHEREAS. N.J.S.A. 40A:14-84, of the Laws of the State of New Jersey authorizes the Board of Fire Commissioners to appropriate funds for the purchase of apparatus related to fire emergency purposes, the amount to be included in the next annual budget of the Fire District under the section for capital appropriations, and

WHEREAS. The Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District #6 of the Township of Gloucester has determined the necessity to appropriate additional funding for the purchase of one *utility body/pickup* fire emergency vehicle is in the best interest of Fire District #6 for fire prevention, extinguishment and public safety, and


WHEREAS. The Board determined that the funding amount of \$86,000.00 is to be part of and appropriately reflected in the Fire District 2026 annual budget, and

WHEREAS. The Board did publish notice of a public hearing on the question to provide additional funding for the purchase of one fire emergency vehicle, and did post notice of the hearing in five public places within the District on the question to purchase of one *COMMAND* emergency vehicle, and did conduct an open public hearing On December 10, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE , it is herein Resolved that the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District # 6 of the Township of Gloucester is hereby authorized to provide funding for purchase one *COMMAND* fire emergency vehicle for an amount not to exceed \$86,000.00, which sum shall be reflected and appropriated in the 2026 annual budget of the Fire District under the section for capital appropriations.
